

Sovereignty

All Living souls are sovereign over their own body and the inalienable rights given by Creator/God. This is inclusive of the Original native people in Australia and around the world. In Australia the bloodline elders can trace their origins back prior to occupation in 1788 and thus their claim as the true custodians of the land is undeniable as established in the Mabo case in 1992.



Sovereign Nations

There are 369 plus native mobs on this Continent and many of them are pursuing their rights and reinvigorating their claim as Sovereign Nations – where sovereign means no other person or body has authority over them; they and their law/lore hold the highest jurisdiction.

In August 2024 the first IFAC (Inter-tribal Foreign Affairs Council) was hosted in Gimay (Cairns) by Yidindji Nation established in 2013. Birri Gubba established in March 2023 and Wakka Wakka established in October 2023 attended, making three sovereign nations present, and a total of 15 mobs all interested in this path. In August 2025 the second IFAC is planned. This Council is not another level of government; it is more of a communications hub and has no other powers.

“Colonisation did not work” was a comment made by an elder last year; this year I would add “Centralisation does not work”. The more centralisation occurs, the bigger the bureaucracy grows, the more power is removed from the people and the less influence the people have. The people are sovereign and we must ensure the power remains with the people.

John Stuart Mill wrote in the essay On Liberty, “There is never a good enough reason to over ride the rights and freedoms of the people.” I think the same must be said of the Sovereign Nations.

In the Wakka Wakka Nation, as documented in the written law of the nation, the Elders of the Senior Council of Elders appoint Ministers to the Tribal Council and just like the National council, this is a communication hub to seek approval from the Elders, who have ultimate responsibility for the Nation to honour human rights and protect the land, air, water, flora and fauna.

All requests and plans come from the people in their local community, be it re-forestation, an extension to the hospital, a housing development, re-routing a road - anything which affects their local community. The Ministers can provide advice and assistance, and ultimately make recommendations to the Elders for their approval.

Some global examples of preserving individual sovereignty:

Sweden in 2020 – when all nations world wide were in lockstep with mandates and closures, the Prime Minister declared that he would not impose any mandates, that the people of Sweden would have to take responsibility and make their own decisions. The result was Sweden’s economy was unaffected and Swedish peoples rights and liberties were honoured.

Russia – I heard an interview with someone who went to Russia because land was affordable and there was no restriction on what you could build on your own land – no building code, no permits and no fees. The owner has responsibility for what he builds. What a concept.

Argentina – President Milei was elected on one policy – Liberty. He told the people all programs would be slashed to meet the budget. While he looked after the budget, the people rose up and the country has started to turn around in just one year – it starts with freedom.

History of the Australian Dollar

Early in the 20th century the Central Bankers influenced Australian Banking by changing the foundation of the Commonwealth Bank from what was essentially a peoples bank with very low interest rates, to a board run by representatives of the commercial banks who thought it unfair that they had to compete with the Commonwealth Bank.

In 1966 the Australian Dollar was introduced as a replacement of the asset backed Pound which is our legal currency according to the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act UK 1900 without a Referendum of the people/states as required by the Constitution.

In the early 70's our currency became fiat as in the USA – a push from the bankers to free up money supply which was supposed to be a benefit. Of course the truth is this implementation paved the way for fractional reserve lending, which creates money out of thin air and undermines any backing required by the banks for safe trading and moderate lending.

What we call inflation is due primarily to: being fiat rather than asset backed, manipulation of money supply and interest rates, fractional lending to a point where some banks will face closure. The plan when this occurred was always to blame the economy or the government and be bailed out with tax-payer funds. This has later morphed into bail-ins, where the customers funds are bailed in when necessary.

While prices go up, it is actually causing the deflation of the currency – the money is worth less. In fact in Australia since the 1940's our currency has halved every decade. Here is a real life example: in 1950 one serve of chips or 3 potato cakes cost 3 pence (say 2.5cents) and today costs \$6. That is a multiplier of 250 times. That is pure manipulation. Manipulated to keep us poor – some will go bankrupt and lose their property. The same for countries. About a year ago I heard that there were 40 countries close to defaulting on their loans.

The European Union

Europe is a great example of a number of sovereign nations and thinking it would be a great idea to have a common currency - and it was. The problem is that in forming the European Union the individual sovereignty of the nations was not preserved. And so today there is discord on issues like tariffs, NATO and wars.

The World Heritage Listing under UNESCO

This was established in 1962. Properties can be listed based on natural or cultural interest. 140 countries signed up and every few years a committee is elected. This committee determines what actions must be taken.

In 1964 Australia handed over the Great Barrier Reef and Kakadu National Park and today have a total of about 22 listings.

This clearly overrides national sovereignty (that is if Australia was actually a nation)

I also think this is the planned destination for "Native Title" which is designated "cultural interest"

Plan to replace the AUD with a resource backed Aussie buck.

Corruptionwhistleblower.com is an evidence based newspaper which is primarily a great educational resource and can also be used as a Brief of Evidence to put politicians etc on notice and can be used in court. This is the production of Peter and Donna. They now have a plan to introduce a wealth backed Aussie Buck to replace the fiat AUD. Here are the steps presented:

1. The JORC (Joint oil and resources committee) – at a cost of over half a million dollars, a full forensic report, JORC compliant, has been produced, showing Australian wealth reserves in the ground to be estimated at five trillion dollars.
2. A preliminary budget indicates that one trillion dollars would pay the military, police, public servants and nurses for 30 years. An important part of the plan is to ave the guns on te payroll so they are on the side of freedom, not corporate.
3. Planned 50,000 dollars equivalent per person as start up.
4. One Aussie Buck = 7.5 AUD; Interest on loans 1%
5. The start up money would incentivize joining plus a commission for signing up others. The first target would be consumers, then business, then distributors/manufacturers. There would also be a bucket for any humanitarian project of merit.
6. An Australian, Gary McAllister, author of the book “Blockchain Prophecy”, has been running a block-chain based money system for eleven years and is offering this system plus support for free to this project. It is a mobile phone App with payments phone to phone.
7. This system includes a block-chain based voting system.
8. Based on the premise that all the resources in the ground are for the mutual benefit of all living souls on the continent. (Suggest that should be ‘indigenous’ meaning born here)
9. Started travelling around to get agreement from all the mobs to give their approval. They claim to have good contact in WA, SA, VIC and NSW – and currently in Qld.
10. Plan to use the blockchain to vote on issues Australia wide.
11. Plan to form a National Council of Elders – this Infers that a National body is deciding on issued by peoples vote and over-riding the sovereignty of individual nations.

This presentation was the first and Peter and Donna are open to feedback.

Yes I think it is a great idea to replace the Central Bank controlled, fiat AUD with a resource backed Aussie Buck that is common across the continent.

My major concern is for sovereignty at an individual level and a nation level.

My suggestions are:

1. Change “all living souls” to “all living souls indigenous to the continent” where indigenous means born in the continent of Australia. This would disallow immigrants from sharing in the common wealth, but allow progeny born here to share.
2. Consideration by Elders of the mineral wealth of the continent:
Option A: as presented – all mineral wealth shared by all inhabitants
Option B: That all mineral wealth is the responsibility of the mobs responsible for that land
Option C: A 50/50 plan where half the wealth goes into a share bucket for all and the other half remains the responsibility of the mob.

The mob who is custodian for the land is always responsible for the care of the land and should retain the ultimate right to decide whether the resource is mined.

Also Sovereign Nations plan to use the value of the mineral wealth in their area for their own currency.

3. Any voting of the people can always be over-riden by the vote of the elders who have the responsibility for care of the land in their territory. So the peoples vote must be referred to the Elders.
4. Initially the only responsibility of this council should be the Aussie Buck
5. Military could be the only other where decisions are made by a council; police, nurses and public servants must be determined by each mob/Sovereign Nation.
6. Another option could be that nationwide budgets are determined in Aussie Bucks and that funding distributed to the nations on a per capita basis.
7. The Council of Elders take responsibility for territory where there is no nation formed and funded by the Aussie Buck in the interim period.
